Pastor's Note

I mused this morning as I watched the weatherman talk about all of the colors on the weather map that represented different forms of precipitation. It reminded me of the chorus, "Jesus Loves the Little Children" and it lists all of the different colors of humanity.

We are about to enter into a new ministry that will incorporate people of color. Our Hispanic sisters and brothers in Christ are needing a place to worship here in Harrodsburg and we want to open our church to them. We will be meeting Wednesday, February 25, for a time of fellowship and discussion with Rev. Eliseo A. Mejia-Levia and Maikel Rojas Perez. Please pray that God will use our church as a conduit of love and grace for all people of color.

March 1, 2015 will begin the interim period for Kevin Burney who will assume the role of District Superintendent. Kevin will be serving through June and will hand over the leadership to Paul Fryman starting in July. We will have a district meeting on May 24 to start the process of renaming our district. Again, let us pray for this period of transition for our Kentucky Annual Conference.

It is that time of year when the district superintendent meets with the pastors and the SPPR Committees to determine whether or not the pastor stays or moves. Sue and I have been in much prayer about our decision and have tried to discern God's will and direction for the ministry here. As best as we can ascertain God's will and purpose for us, we told Rev. Jean Hawxhurst that we would like to stay. Please understand that ultimately, it is Bishop Davis and the Cabinet's decision whether or not we stay or move. This process takes place over the next two months and word will come to let us know the results of their collaboration. Please pray that God will give guidance to all who are involved in this process all across our Annual Conference.
