


Liberty, KY. Please give labels to Janice Yount (or leave at the church office). Janice collects for the Doris Davis Circle as a mission project.

Wesley Group Food Baskets

As best I can calculate 2015 is the 17th year that the Harrodsburg United Methodist Church has distributed food baskets/boxes to the Harrodsburg and Mercer County communities at Christmas. We started out



small the first year in 1998 with 25 baskets, increasing to 35, 50, 100 and later 200. A couple of years we distributed 250 boxes, but because of costs we have settled on 200 boxes. The contents of the boxes change every year depending on the cost of items, but we have always included a 3-4 pound ham in each box. When we first started we used plastic laundry baskets which cost only 99 cents, but over time these too became too expensive and we switched to cardboard banana boxes. These boxes are sturdy enough to hold the 51 pounds of food we include in each box. Thanks to Tony Russell for gathering and preparing the boxes for use. If you add a gallon of milk to each box the total weight is about 59 pounds which is 11,800 pounds, or nearly 6 tons of food. Our

nearly 6 tons of food. O CHURCH and YOU do make a difference!

You can be proud of what your church does for the community. These boxes provide enough food for a family of 4 to be fed for two weeks. In the last 17 years we have distributed about 160,000 pounds (or 80 tons) of food to the families that need it. "To the families that need it", this is key to our success. We continue to collaborate with the Christian Life Center to identify those people who should receive the food boxes. They know first -hand of the families that are truly in need. Thank you Cassie Barker and the others at the Christian Life Center for helping make this effort successful each and every year. Collectively



there are 200 families who will have a Merry Christmas. Not only do they have wholesome food during the holidays, but hopefully your efforts have touched their hearts.

Our church is blessed to have the talent and resources to undertake an effort like this year after year and I want to thank you for your generosity, the time and effort of many volunteers who helped to secure the food items, assembly and delivery of the boxes. We give the glory to God!
