Liberty, KY. This will be discontinued December 31, 2016


Pregnancy Resource Center

On August 1st, I began my new appointment as pastor of Triple Cross Cowboy Church. I am a Master of Divinity student at Asbury Theological Seminary in Wilmore, and am a candidate for ordained ministry as an elder in the Yellowstone Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church. I moved here from Cody, Wyoming to study on the Wilmore campus. Wyoming is the Cowboy State and I have a deep love of all things western and equine, so I can hardly think of a better fit for me than a cowboy church in the middle of Kentucky horse country!

For any of you who might not be familiar with Triple Cross, the church is beginning its fourth year as a United Methodist ministry. We came into being through the collaborative efforts and steadfast support of the people of Triple Cross Cowboy Church, Harrodsburg United Methodist Church, and the New Church Development Team of the Kentucky Annual Conference. We meet on the roughly 20 acre property owned by Harrodsburg UMC located on Industrial Way.

We kicked-off our new ministry year by hosting a cook-out and games night for the local High School Rodeo team on August 6. The event was well attended and it looks like the Rodeo team will be welcoming some new members this year. This fall Triple Cross is hosting Kentucky High School Rodeo Association rodeos on <u>August 27-28th and October 8-9th</u>. On <u>September 17-18th</u> we will host a Kentucky Junior Rodeo Association rodeo. I am excited about the unique opportunities these events provide for ministry to the participating children, youth and their families.

Triple Cross meets every Thursday evening at 6:30pm. On the third Thursday of each month we have a worship service and then share a pot-luck, and on all of the other Thursdays we share our pot-luck first and then have Bible study. All are welcome, and we'd love to have you join us for an evening of worship, fellowship, food and fun!

Thank you, people of Harrodsburg UMC for the warm welcome you have extended to me. I will be here to worship with you most Sundays and I look forward to getting to know you individually and as a church.
