
### **Pregnancy Resource Center**


# **Digital Bible**



Just1Word, Inc.

I recently filled-in for Alex Mace (Youth Director) for his Sunday School Class. As former teacher of the senior high Sunday school class it is always nice to return. I arrived to class a little early to get things set up and had in mind to read some from the Bible. Well we have two or three different Bibles in the classroom and then it struck



me to see how many of our young adult students had an "APP" for the Bible on their phones. Are you ready for that answer? 100%

Recently Pastor Hawkins has been referencing multiple readings from the Bible to enlighten us with similar subjects but from multiple authors, namely Mathew, Mark, Luke, and John and last Sunday Acts. This allows us to better understand when multiple authors record the same happening. It gives you a fuller understanding.

Well for some time now I have had this Bible APP on my iPhone. I have tried others, but this one is free and easy to use. The application is from Just1Word, INC. and looks just like the ICON above when you find it from the App Store. I like it because you don't have to have Wi-Fi to use it – you can use it offline. It has both the Old and New Testaments and is easily and quickly referenced. Additionally the application has multiple translations – 20+ different translations. I have the NIV version. See an example of the application to the left. I think you will like it. Also you can adjust the font so you always have a readable version for the user.

So, if you see one of the youth or me looking at my iPhone during church, it is to look up a Bible verse.



Meets 3rd Tuesday of the month at 10 AM in church. Join us for a great meeting and lots of fun.


## <u>Book Nook</u>
