

Missionary Update Chris Hanak

Dear Praying Friends,

Thank you so much for being part of Focus on the Heart's work in India, helping your sisters in Christ grow more like Him through the painful experiences in their lives. Many of the women in the 3 groups I met with had encouraging reports of how God has been working in their lives as a result of what they have been learning. One woman shared, "Now I have peace! For many years I suffered alone. I'm so glad I came to FOH and now I know others who understand and accept me."

Several of the women I met with this time are now helping facilitate courses for small groups of women -- this is the multiplication we have been praying for! Our mission, Ambassadors for Christ International (AFCI), believes that the most effective missionaries in each country are those who share the same culture, language, and experiences as those they train. This is the reason that we focus on training leaders in each country who can carry on the ministry of FOH.

In facilitating this course and sharing these new ideas, I had the wonderful help of two leaders, Esther and Jennitha. Both are experienced missionaries and have gone further through the courses than this group. They will facilitate this course for missionaries from the northern parts of India next week. Please remember them in your prayers
