Pastor's Notes

Well, we're settling into the parsonage and into the rhythm of Harrodsburg UMC. I know I have a lot to learn, and so I want to ask for your help.

NAMES

It will take a while to learn your names. Some people are very good at names and faces, others of us can be a bit slow. Please, for the first month at least, when you meet me or shake my hand, tell me your name. I will learn much more quickly that way. And please, no quizzes... You know, "Do you remember me?", that sort of thing. When I do, I'll call your name. Until then, I'm still trying to get it into my memory. Also—we all learn the names of people we have a lot of interaction with more quickly than those we meet only once or twice. So I hope you'll be ready to attend worship, committee and leadership meetings, potlucks, spaghetti dinners, Sunday School, and Bible Study. As we spend time together, we'll get to know one another better (and I'll remember your name more easily.)

ROUTINES

Every church has its own rhythm and its own routines. I want to learn yours—how you worship, how you fellowship, how you interact with one another, how we interact with the community of Harrodsburg. I also have personal rhythm and routines—things I'm used to doing a certain way. I hope we'll all feel comfortable asking and answering questions about our routines. Such conversations help us understand one another more quickly and begin to mesh with one another the way a church family should.

CALL ME

Because I'm new, there's a lot I don't know. Obviously, I'll be learning your names, and the way we do things around church. But—if you are going to the hospital, I won't know that unless you tell me. I won't know which hospital you're in unless you tell me. If there's a special need in your family for pastoral care, I won't know that unless you tell me. Please call me—I'll have the parsonage cell phone with me always, and I have a personal one as well—502.751.7574. I do want to know what is going on in your life, and how I might be with you as you go through whatever you are going through.

Also, a reminder—the demands of the HIPA regulations (health privacy act) are so stringent that even if I identify myself to a hospital staff person as your pastor, they can't tell me if you are there. If we know you by your nickname at church, but the hospital knows you by your formal given name—if I don't have that name correct, they can't tell me you're there. ALSO—I've been around a long time, long enough to know that some people want visitors when they're in the hospital and others don't. I will honor your wishes, whatever they may be—but again, you need to tell me. Call me, or have a family member call me, and I'll respond as best as I am able.

I am so looking forward to getting to know all of you and getting into the swing of things here at Harrodsburg UMC. I know we're going to have a great time following Jesus and serving all the people Jesus loves together.
