**In-Person Communion Service November 8, 22, 2020** 

November is here! Normally we'd be gearing up for our big holiday season ministries—the Thanksgiving Meal for our Thursday Night guests; planning and organizing for the Food Box distribution the week or so after Thanksgiving; and then, of course, the Hanging of the Green. That's in addition to Sunday School parties, the Wesley dinner for some Christmas families, and all of the warm fellowship that surrounds each of these events.

Of course that's all different in the Covid-19 year. We will be doing a virtual Hanging of the Green using last year's service as the skeleton for that. We've cancelled the Wesley dinner, and we haven't been able to do our Thursday Night meal for nearly a year now. And, we aren't able to do the massive, 200+ food box event that has become such a tradition.

#### But.....

We are donating what will be a total of \$5,000 or more—what we would have used for the food boxes—to the CLC this year to support their work to relieve suffering here in Mercer County. We'll be doing that in installments throughout the last two months of the year so that the CLC remains fully stocked and able to meet the needs of our neighbors. So in spite of the isolation created by COVID-19 precautions, we are still finding ways to reach out to the community in meaningful ways. Thank you to John and Carol Moffett and all the folks they work with who are part of the Wesley Group for being so creative and resilient.




